TEAMS SHALL PROVIDE:

1. A synthetic size 3 competition football.
2. Field umpire and goal umpire (with flags) / scorer.
3. Mouthguards and football boots are recommended for all players.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

Conduct: All players, teachers, spectators and officials are bound by the SSV Codes of Conduct.

Umpiring: Each team shall provide a field umpire and goal umpire.

Scoring: Scorecards will be provided and shall be recorded by a competent representative from each team (can be the goal umpire).

Team: Up to 25 players per team (18 players on field). A girl cannot play in the Boys/Mixed Team as well as the Girls Team.

Ball: Synthetic football size 3.

Dress: Players must wear matching jumpers with distinctive numbers, same coloured shorts (without pockets) and same coloured socks. No jewellery may be worn.

FORMAT:

1. A Round Robin Competition.
2. Matches are centrally timed, 4 x **10 minute quarters**, with 5 minute intervals and change of ends.
3. Match points are awarded 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss.
4. At the conclusion of the Round Robin Matches, the team finishing with the highest total points will be declared the Division Winner and is eligible to progress on to the Region Final. If two teams are tied on points then the team that won their head-to-head round robin matches finishes higher. If their head-to-head matches were a draw (or one win each), then percentage from their head-to-head matches will determine the winner. If still tied, the total percentage all their round robin matches will be used. If more than two teams are tied on points, percentage from their head-to-head matches will be calculated to determine the winner (or all matches in the case of the result still being tied).

RULES OF COMPETITION:

Rules: Conducted under the Laws of Australian Football unless otherwise stated. Play is started (and resumed after a goal is scored) by a ball-up. Only four players per team are permitted near the ball-up. All other players must begin 20+m away. Field ball-ups will be contested by two similar players selected by the field umpire and may not necessarily be the closest/tallest. Where the ball is touched out of bounds, play will be re-started with a ball-up conducted 5m in from the boundary. (Free kick awarded to nearest opposition player for balls kicked out of bounds on the full). A player is permitted one bounce before disposing of the ball to another player. Free kick is awarded to the nearest opposition player for deliberately kicking the ball off the ground. Tackling and side-on bumping is permitted. Slingsing is not permitted. A player can be given a yellow card by an umpire (10min send-off) for not following the Code of Conduct. This player may not be replaced.

Interchange: Players may be interchanged at any time during the match from the wing area.

Bloodrule: Player is removed and substituted immediately and can be re-substituted.
