TEAMS SHALL PROVIDE:

1. A size 4 competition soccer ball.
2. Linesperson (&/or Referee) and Scorer.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY: useful link: [Primary Rules Football \(Soccer\) \(ssv.vic.edu.au\)](http://ssv.vic.edu.au)

Conduct: All players, teachers, spectators and officials are bound by the SSV Codes of Conduct.
Umpiring: Each team shall provide a linesperson. Schools may bring their own referee.
Scoring: Scorecards will be provided and shall be recorded by a competent representative from each team.
Team: Up to 14 players per team (9 players on the field including GK) with rolling substitutions.
Ball: Soccer ball size 4.
Dress: Players must wear the same uniform (numbered where possible). The goalkeeper must wear a contrasting colour shirt. Shinguards are compulsory, mouthguards strongly recommended and no jewellery is permitted.

FORMAT:

1. A Round Robin Competition on two pitches with two Boys/Mixed Pools and a Girls Pool.
2. Matches are centrally timed, **Boys/Mixed 2 x 7 minute halves** and **Girls 2 x 6 minute halves** with 2 minute interval at half-time followed by a change of ends. There will be 2 minutes between matches.
3. Match points are awarded 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss.
4. At the conclusion of the Round Robin Pool Matches, the **Boys/Mixed** teams will play crossover positional finals of **2 x 9 min halves** against the other Pool, as Pool A 1st v Pool B 1st – declared the Division Winner and eligible to progress to the Region Final, 2v2, 3v3 and 4v4. If two teams are tied on points at the end of the Round Robin Pool Matches, then the team which won their head-to-head pool match finishes higher. If their head-to-head match was a draw, then total goal difference from all their pool matches will determine the winner. If it's still a tie, then the team with the most goals scored, then least goals scored against. If more than two teams are tied on points, goal difference from their head-to-head matches will be calculated to determine the winner. If the scores are tied at the conclusion of the 1st v 1st match there will be extra time of 3 min each end. If the scores are still tied an extra 3 min each end of golden goal time will be played where the match is won by the team that scores first and the match is immediately concluded. Repeat golden goal ends of 3 minutes until a goal is scored. **(The match will not be decided on penalties, as this is time-consuming and an unnecessary pressure for young athletes at this level of competition.)**
5. At the conclusion of the Round Robin Matches, the **Girls** team finishing with the highest total points will be declared the Division Winner and be eligible to progress on to the Region Final. If two teams are tied on points then the team which won their head-to-head round robin match finishes higher. If their head-to-head match was a draw, then total goal difference from all their round robin matches will determine the winner. If it's still a tie, then the team with the most goals scored, then least goals scored against. If more than two teams are tied on points, goal difference from their head-to-head matches will be calculated to determine the winner.

Rules: Conducted under the FIFA 9 v 9 Laws of the Game rules, unless otherwise stated.
Interchange: Players may interchange when the ball is out of play (notify the referee prior) or during half-time. Substituted players may return to the field at a later stage.
Bloodrule: Player is removed and substituted immediately and can be re-substituted at the next appropriate break in play.
