Schools need to provide

- Size 5 basketball for matches
- First aid bag to deal with minor injuries. As well as strapping tape if required.

Uniforms

- Uniform singlets/tops with player number
- Shorts must not have pockets.

Officials

Umpires – The division has organised for one referee to be present per match.

Coaches/Supervisors – Each school is to provide one coach for their team who should make themselves known to the convenor at the start of the day.

Timekeeper/Scoring – Each team will need to provide one person to be responsible for timekeeping and scoring for all their matches. Hard copy score sheets will be provided and must be used for each game, digital scoreboards will also be at each court, if you wish to use these as well.

First aid officer – A first aid officer will be present, but schools are encouraged to bring their own first aid supplies to deal with minor injuries.

Conditions of play

All sports are conducted under the School Sport Victoria's '[General Conditions of Competition](#)'

All players, teachers, spectators, and officials are bound by the '[SSV Codes of Conduct](#)'

Game lengths are 2 x 10minute halves with a 2minute half time interval, teams change direction at half time.

Basketball will be conducted using the SSV's [Primary Rules Basketball \(ssv.vic.edu.au\)](http://ssv.vic.edu.au), unless otherwise stated in this document.

Division Rules for timings, interchange, timeouts, and clock stoppages

The game clock will commence when the game is scheduled to start.

If there is a delay commencing the day an adjustment of times or game lengths may be required. This will be communicated by the convenor Geoff McShane.

Players can be interchanged throughout each game. There isn't a limit to the number of substitutions a team can make during a game. Injured players and players who have received five fouls may be replaced.

Each team is allowed **one time-out per half** of one minute. **The clock does not stop for team timeouts** unless taken in the last two minutes of the second half, see below.

The clock will only stop for timeout if they are taken in the last two minutes of the second half.

The clock will stop on all referee whistles **during the last one minutes of the second half** or for a **referee timeout**, see below. If a game goes into overtime the clock will only stop for referee timeout.

Teams are not permitted to take timeouts during the last minute of the first half.

Team timeouts cannot be taken during additional time if a game goes into overtime.

The Referee may call a time-out to allow the substitution of:

- (a) An injured player.
- (b) A player who has received 5 fouls.
- (c) A player who has been ordered off the court.

During a Referee's time-out, the clock will be stopped.

Game format

Nillumbik boys/mixed

- Will be split into two groups.
- Group 1 - Montmorency, Sugarloaf, and the two Eltham teams.
- Group 2 – Three Diamond Valley teams
 - Group 1
 - Semi final & grand final playoffs. The winners from the semi final will playoff in the grand final the losers from the semi final will have a 3rd and 4th playoff.
 - The winner from the grand final will progress to the Nillumbik playoff at the end of the day.
 - If teams are tied at the end of the game the game will be extended by 2 mins, no additional timeouts will be allowed. An additional 2 mins will be added until a result is reached.
 - Group 2
 - Three team round robin.
 - Four points for a win, two for a draw and zero for a loss.

- The team with the most points will progress to the Nillumbik playoff at the end of the day.
- If two teams are equal on points the winner from their head-to-head match will be declared the winner.
- If their face-to-face match was a draw, then total percentage from all their games will be used to determine the winner.
- The winner from group 1 and group 2 will playoff at the end of the day if this match is tied at the end of the game the game will be extended by 2 mins, this will continue until a result is reached. No extra timeouts will be permitted.

Nillumbik Girls

- The two Eltham school will playoff to create a winner from the Eltham District.
- The two Diamond Valley school will playoff to create a winner from the Diamond Valley District.
- If these playoff games are a tie at the end of normal time an additional 2 mins will be played, this will continue until there is a result.
- Once a winner has been confirmed from these districts, they will play a three team round robin with the Monty school.
- During the round robin teams will receive 4 points for a win two points for a draw and no points for a loss.
- The team with the most points at the end of the competition will progress to the NMR final.
- If two teams are level on points at the end of the round robin the winner from their head-head game will be awarded the win.
- If their head-head match is a draw or three or more teams are equal on points then total percentage for all games will be used.
- The losers from the Eltham and Diamond Valley playoff game will play a consolation game to ensure they have an extra match on the day. The result of this game will not affect the

Darebin boys/mixed and girls

- Will be round robin competitions.
- Four points will be awarded for a win, two points will be awarded for a draw, and zero points will be awarded for a loss.
- The team with the most points at the end of the competition will progress to the NMR final.
- If two teams are level on points at the end of the round robin the winner from their head-head game will be awarded the win.
- If their head-head match is a draw or three or more teams are equal on points then total percentage for all games will be used.
