### **COVID-19 SAFE PRACTICES**

- No Spectators permitted at this event- spectators will be turned away to ensure the event can run in line with the venue's COVID-Safe plan.
- Competitors travel with schools where possible. If transportation cannot be provided by the school, a maximum of <u>ONE</u> Supervising Adult per swimmer will be permitted. Any more than one supervising adult per competitor will be turned away. We ask that you adhere to event times and also vacate the venue after your events have been completed, to allow the event to stay within capacity limits.
- All adults will be asked to 'sign in' on entry, either via QR Code or on paper.
- Events have been staggered in 'blocks' to allow for competitors and supervising adults to vacate the venue after their event/s have taken place. We ask that you please adhere to this to ensure maximum capacity within the pool hall is maintained.
- Face masks to be carried and worn if not able to socially distance 1.5m
- Supervising adults and competitors will be asked to sit in a designated section, based on the Division they are representing, and will need to stay in this area until they are called to the marshalling room for their event.

# **PROTESTS**

Protests must be notified to the Referee in Charge on the day of competition only by either the competitor or teacher or adult responsible for the competitor.

Any competitor aggrieved by the ruling of the Referee may request to compete under protest (in the case of a disqualification/failed attempt) until their Appeal can be heard.

After the Referee has made his/her decision, there is an opportunity to lodge an appeal in writing with the Convenor within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the race or the Referee's decision, whichever comes first. There is an appeal fee of AUD\$50 cash to accompany any appeal.

Presentations will be withheld whilst any protest or appeal is being heard.

No protests or appeals will be heard after the day the competition is conducted.
