

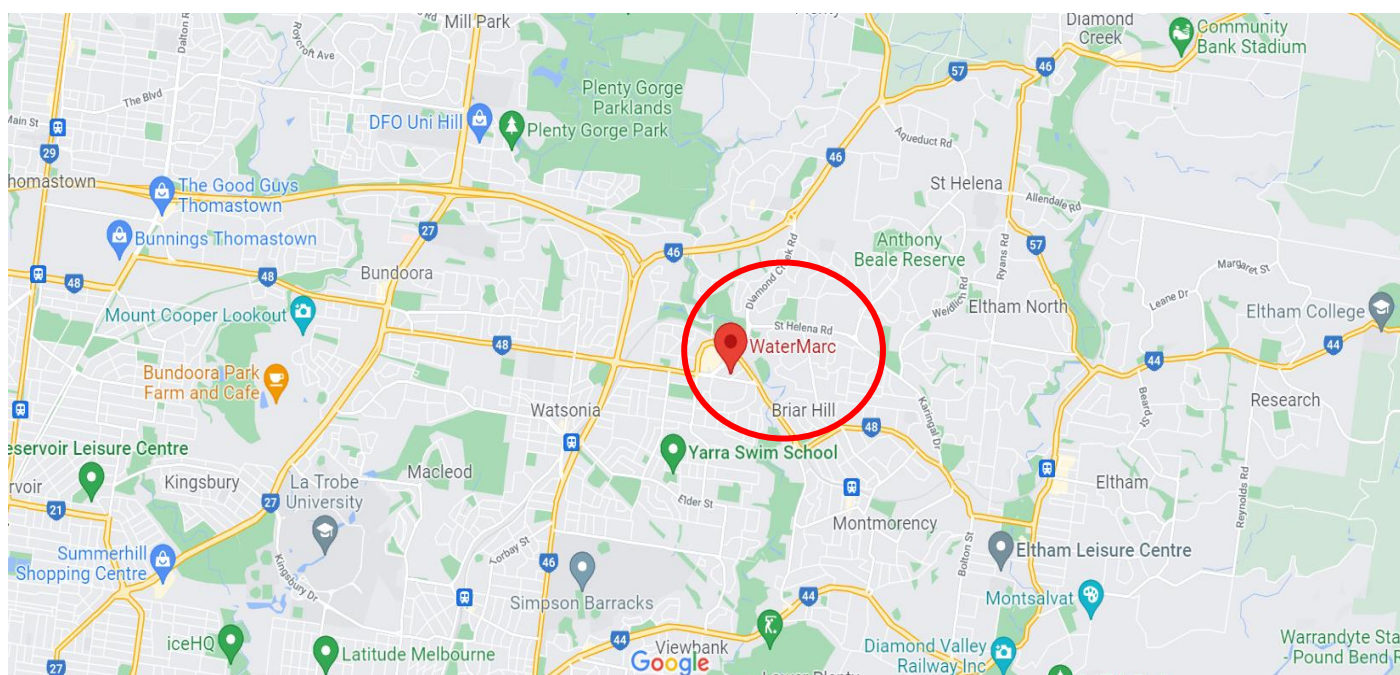

COVID SAFE PRACTICES & QR CHECK IN

- **Competitors travel with schools where possible. If transportation cannot be provided by the school, a maximum of ONE Supervising Adult per swimmer will be permitted. Any more than one supervising adult per competitor will be turned away. We ask that you adhere to event times and also vacate the venue after your events have been completed, to allow the event to stay within capacity limits.**
- All SSV events are conducted under [COVID Safe Practices](#)- all attendees are asked to familiarise themselves with these documents. Please also check the [Coronavirus & School Sport News page](#) for updates as well.
- Please do not arrive any earlier than **30 minutes prior to your event time**.
- All attendees excluding participants (i.e. teachers, parents, guardians, spectators, officials, etc.) must register using the QR Code at the venue to record attendance on the day.
- If you are 12 years & older remember to have a mask with you in the event that you cannot socially distance 1.5m.

COMPETITION RULES & POLICIES

- Swimming is conducted under the rules of **Australian Swimming Inc.** and the [SSV Swimming Primary and Secondary Rules](#) unless otherwise stated.
- No coaches or parents are allowed on the concourse on the inside of the bunting at any time. Photography and or filming may only be undertaken from the seated spectator area and the medal presentation area only.
- Warm ups** can only be held in the **main pool prior to 10:15am**. After this time, competitors won't have access to any facilities to warm up and will need to conduct a 'dry' warm up. Competitors who use the adjacent toddler/children's pool for warm ups may be asked by venue and/or event management to leave the premises as this is a violation of the hire agreement.
- All events will be run using the **'timed final' format**; the top 3 place getters of each timed final for the same stroke in each age group will be asked to remain at a designated holding area until results are compared and confirmed. The fastest 3 times across the two timed finals will be presented with 1st, 2nd & 3rd NMR Region Medallions. The student or relay team members presented with the First Place (1st) medallion/s have qualified to attend the SSV State Swimming Championships. VENUE & PARKING

- Entry to the NMR Primary Swimming Championships is via **Grimshaw St**- please follow the signage from the main entrance/reception area on Flintoff St to the designated entrance on Grimshaw St.
- Parking is available around the venue- please see below for further info.
- Café facilities are available to purchase food and drink from inside the venue.

PROTESTS

- Protests must be notified to the Referee in Charge on the day of competition only by either the competitor **or** teacher/adult responsible for the competitor.
- Any competitor aggrieved by the ruling of the Referee may request to compete under protest (in the case of a disqualification/failed attempt) until their Appeal can be heard.
- After the Referee has made his/her decision, there is an opportunity to lodge an appeal in writing with the Convenor within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the race or the Referee's decision, whichever comes first. There is an appeal fee of **AUD\$50 cash to accompany any appeal**.
- Presentations will be withheld whilst any protest or appeal is being heard.
- No protests or appeals will be heard after the day the competition is conducted.

STATE FINALS INFORMATION

- Competitors awarded 1st place in either individual or relay events will progress to the SSV State Swimming Championships. All state information can be found on the [School Sport Victoria website](#).
- Any qualifying swimmer who is not able to compete at the SSV State Swimming Championships should advise their School Sport Victoria Coordinator who will contact SSV so they may offer the opportunity to the next placed swimmer. Swimmers can only be replaced by SSV staff and only if significant notice (no less than 3 school days prior to the event) is provided by the school of the student concerned.

Options around Greensborough

On-site 2-hour and 3-hour visitor parking is available on Levels 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the multi-deck carpark and in the basement carpark underneath Council's offices. These carparks are accessible from Flintoff St and Para Rd.

Disabled parking (6 spaces) are available on the top level (L5) of the multi-deck carpark. These have direct access to the ground level of the Council building. A further 4 disabled parking spaces are situated on level 3 of the multi-deck carpark and are accessible via Flintoff St.

- Event times noted above are just a guide, swimmers are encouraged to be ready to be marshalled approx. 15 minutes prior to their event time. Schools/students should take note of what event is in the pool to gauge the progress of the event. Students should approach the Marshall Room if they are uncertain as to when to check in.
- All spectators must adhere to the entry conditions of the Venue. Masks must be worn inside the venue and social distancing adhered to where possible and in line with Victorian Government Requirements. Schools, Student's and Spectators attending are expected to take responsibility to ensure for the safety of all in attendance, general spectators are discouraged due to the ability of the venue to monitor social distancing.
