PLAYING CONDITIONS

Region Final Format:	Split Round Robin, Semi Finals and Final
Region Match Format	A singles competition between two (2) individual players who have qualified from each of the six Sports Divisions. A total of 12 boys and 12 girls.
Region Final Winner:	The winning player will be decided on matches won. If two players are equal on matches won, then the player that won the face-to-face match between the two tied players will be declared the winner.
Officials/Coaching:	Children are to umpire and call lines of their own matches. If there is a dispute that cannot be resolved the court supervisor/referee can be called onto the court to resolve the problem. No coaching is allowed during any match. Parents and players are reminded of the Code of Conduct that applies at all School Sport events.
Dress:	Competitors must be dressed in their school sports uniform or in neat tennis clothing. Tracksuits may not be worn during play. Board shorts (surf shorts) are not acceptable. Shirts with designs, large manufacturer's logos or advertising are not acceptable. Tennis shoes with flat tread must be worn. Players not correctly dressed will not be permitted to compete.
Lateness Penalty:	If a player is late for the start of their match for reasons beyond their control and the player communicates with the convenor, then the convenor will try to accommodate the player as best he/she can.
Equipment to bring:	Each player to provide their own personal equipment.

Draw Structure

- There will be four pools with 3 players in each pool.
- Each player will participate in 2 pool matches.
- The player who has won the most pool matches will progress to the semi-finals. If two players are equal on matches won, then the player that won the face-to-face match between the two tied players will progress to the semi-finals.
- All pool singles matches will be the first to 8 games with a tie break at 7-all.
- All semi-finals singles matches will be the first to 6 games with a tie break at 5 all.
- Final singles match will be the first to 6 games with a tie break at 5 all.
- In all games 'Sudden Death' is played at deuce (the player that wins the next point, wins the game). The receiver elects the side that the server serves to.
