## INCLEMENT WEATHER


- All efforts will be made to hold this event regardless of weather conditions, in line with the [SSV Extreme weather and catastrophic events guidelines](#).
- Should the need to postpone the event arise, a decision will be made by the convenor and Division Coordinator no later than **8:15am** on the day of competition.
- Should inclement weather arise during competition, the convenor has the power to suspend or resume play, in addition to actions such as altering the draw or amending the competition format to ensure the competition is as fair and equitable as possible for all competitors.

## COMPETITION STRUCTURE

- Matches will consist of a **singles competition** between two (2) individual players.
- Competitors in the girl's draw will play each other once. The top 3 players will qualify for the NMR finals.
- The boys draw will be split into pools of three (3) or four (4) players. The players that win the most matches in their pool will automatically qualify for the NMR finals. The players who finish second in each pool will play off in a final to determine the 3<sup>rd</sup> qualifier.
- If **two players are equal on matches won**, then the **player that won the face-to-face match** between the two tied players will be awarded the higher place.
- If **three players are equal on matches won**, then **games percentage (games won / games played)** will be compared in the matches involving the three players to determine the winner.
- The convenor has the authority to modify/adjust the program if needed. An example of this is due to inclement/extreme weather.

## MATCH CONDITIONS & RULES

- Tennis is conducted under the rules of the *International Tennis Federation (ITF)* unless otherwise stated.
- All matches will be the **first to 4 games with a tie break at 3-all. Tie-breaker is first to 7 points with a 2 point advantage.**
- **In all games 'Sudden Death' is played at deuce** (the player that wins the next point, wins the game). The receiver elects the side that the server serves to.
- **Lateness Penalty:** *If a player is late for the start of their match for reasons beyond their control and the player communicates with the convenor, then the convenor will try to accommodate the player*



as best he/she can. If no communication is made to the convener, then the late player may forfeit their game for the match that they have missed.

## EQUIPMENT AND OFFICIALS

- Students are to **umpire and 'call lines'** for their own matches. If there is a dispute that cannot be resolved the convenor can be called upon to resolve the problem.
- The convenor has **final say** on the action to be taken in such instances.
- **No coaching** is allowed during any match. Parents, spectators, coaches and players are reminded of the [Code of Conduct](#) that applies at all School Sport Victoria events.
- Competitors are required to provide their own personal equipment. Match balls will be supplied.

## DRESS

- Competitors must be dressed in their school sports uniform or in neat tennis clothing. Tracksuits may not be worn during play. Board shorts (surf shorts) are not acceptable. Shirts with designs, large manufacturer's logos or advertising are not acceptable. Tennis shoes with flat tread must be worn.
- Players **not correctly dressed will not be permitted to compete**.

## FIRST AID

- There will be **no first aid service** supplied for this event. The convenor will have a first aid kit available for use.
- If required, competitors must bring their own **EpiPen's and asthma kits** to the event. Competitors are responsible for their own anaphylaxis and asthma equipment and cannot rely on event first aid resources for these instances.
- **Any strapping or taping requirements** will be the players responsibility to have complete prior to game time. There will be no provisions for strapping and/or taping from event management.

## REGION FINALS INFORMATION

- The winner of each pool and the winner of the playoff game will qualify to the [Northern Region Tennis \(Individual\) Final](#)
