Reminder - Equipment to Bring:

- All playing equipment including helmets with face grids
- A full set of stumps and bails 2 sets of portable stumps recommended (with base and bails) minimum 1 set of portable stumps required.
- Pitch type & Length Outfield or hard wicket surface. 16m length measured stump to stump.
- Boundary markers 40m (maximum) Boundary is to be measured from the batter's end stumps
- Year 8 & 7 Girls shall use a modified ball (circumference 21-22.5cm, ideal weight 120-140g). *Synthetic options available as per Stage 1 Modified Balls Guidance.
- Competing teams will need to bring their own match balls for State Quarter-finals & also practice balls. Match balls will be provided for State Semi-Finals & Finals.
- A competent scorer and a scorebook.
- A square leg umpire
- A first aid kit.
