TEAM VIC INFORMATION SHEET 2025

The School Sport Victoria (SSV) Team Vic representative program provides an opportunity for Victoria's emerging student athletes to challenge themselves against Australia's best school aged athletes across numerous sports at the annual School Sport Australia (SSA) Championships.

SSV coordinate the selection process for Team Vic teams in partnership with relevant state sporting organisations. Depending on the sport and team, the selection process involves either:

- Progressive or conference model
- State trial/s
- Results from event/s
- Based on rankings/results or talent identification program

To be eligible for selection, students must:

- Be a full-time student that attends school regularly with a School Sport Victoria member school;
- Have their selection in the team endorsed by their school Principal;
- Not be suspended / banned from competing in interschool, community/club or representative sport;
- Be available to attend selection trials and training sessions; and
- Meet the costs of participation.

Students registering for trials are indicating that they will be available for all stages of the trial process. For information on the sports and teams participating in the SSA Championships, please refer to the individual <u>Team Vic sport pages</u> on the SSV website.

REGISTRATIONS

All students must register to trial for Team Vic via the registration link on each <u>Team Vic sport</u> <u>page</u>. The registration dates for each sport can be found on the <u>Team Vic Sport and</u> <u>Registrations Key Dates page</u>.

Registration information for other teams will be published closer to the time of registrations opening through the <u>SSV website</u>, and may be published on social media platforms including <u>Facebook</u> and <u>Instagram</u>, and the <u>SSV eNews</u>. Please note the following:

- A fee of \$35.00 applies to each sport registration;
- There is no late registration period for any sport in 2025;







- It is the responsibility of the student/parent/carer, to check the SSV website for opening and closing dates for registrations.;
- The registration opening and closing dates will differ for each team; and
- Registration confirmation will come from GameDay and not SSV.

CONDUCT

Both <u>SSV</u> and <u>SSA</u> have Codes of Conduct to ensure a positive experience throughout the trial process and Championship events. It is imperative that all participants are familiar with these expectations as well as the consequences of breaching the codes prior to participating in the trials or in Championship events.

SELECTION PROGRESSION AND TEAM ANNOUNCMENTS

Trialists will be notified as to whether they have progressed to the next selection stage generally within a week of the trial(s) concluding. If it has been more than a week and you have not received notification, please <u>contact a member of the National Programs Team</u> <u>at SSV</u>.

Team Vic teams will be announced via the SSV website generally within 7 business days of the final trial.

MULTICLASS

Information regarding multiclass events, classification, scoring and sporting opportunities is available on the <u>Multiclass page</u> on the SSV website.

PARTICIPATION COSTS

Participation in SSV Team Vic representative teams is fully self-funded, so families will be required to meet the costs of their child being a member of a team. Such costs include host state and administration levies, training and team equipment costs, uniform, transport, accommodation, and meals.

Please note, a parent/carer is required to travel with their child to the SSA Championship and be primarily responsible for the supervision of their child outside of official SSA Championship activities.

SSV can provide some indicative costs to help families budget and meet the costs of participation. The cost of the SSA Championships host state and administration levies and Team Vic uniform is approximately \$1400.00 per student. All costs associated with travel, accommodation and meals for a student and parent/carer will be in addition to







the costs above. These costs will vary and depend upon the location and timing of the Championship and are the responsibility of the parent/carer.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The main fundraising approach available to families is the <u>Australian Sports Foundation</u>, which provides an online platform to assist with the costs of participating in the SSA Championships. The platform enables enable prospective sponsors, schools, community clubs, families and friends to assist with your fundraising efforts.

Furthermore, the <u>Sports Excellence Scholarship Fund</u> grants \$1000.00 scholarships to emerging athletes facing financial hardship. Athletes aged 10-18 years old who have been selected to represent their state, territory or Australia are eligible to apply on their website.
