### Diving, 10–19 Years

The School Sport Australia (SSA) 10-19 Years Diving Championships will be held in Adelaide, SA from Saturday 10 August - Friday 16 August, 2024.

#### Age Eligibility:

- Turning 10 to 19 years of age as at 31 December 2024 i.e. born in 2014, 2013, 2012, 2011, 2010, 2009, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005
- Students turning 9 years old in 2024 are ineligible for selection

#### SSV Member Schools:

- Trialling for Team Vic is only possible if your child's school is a financial member of School Sport Victoria (SSV) for 2024
- SSV will contact you if the school your child attends is not a financial member

#### Trials Progression:

- Trial participants are required to participate in the Team Vic Diving Selection Trial
- There will be no other trials in the selection process including the SSV State Championships
- Selectors reserve the right to consider divers who, at the time of the trials, are competing at an event deemed to be of a higher status

#### State Selection:

- To be eligible for selection, students must enter and compete in the Team Vic Diving Selection Trials
- Up to 3 students will be considered for selection per individual event, per age group, per gender
- Synchro pairs will be determined from the selected team
- The selected team will be posted on the SSV website in the week after the trials. Successful trialists will receive an email from SSV requesting them to accept their place in the team.

#### Nominations:

- The Team Vic Diving Selection Trials are conducted by Diving Victoria on behalf of School Sport Victoria
- Diving Victoria will receive all nominations for the trials
- Entry Fee: \$25 Registration plus \$15 per Team Vic Selection Trial event (springboard &/or platform)
- Divers must nominate and register for Team Vic via the registration link: <u>https://www.divingvictoria.com.au/events/228031/</u>
- Entries open at 9:00am Sunday 31 March, 2024
- Entries will close at 11:59pm Sunday 21 April, 2024
- Only divers nominating via this process will be considered eligible for selection

#### Springboard

- Any combination of 1 m and/or 3 m dives
- No dive can be repeated

10 years	2 dives from 2 groups @ 3.62	plus	2 dives from 2 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
11 years	2 dives from 2 groups @ 3.6	plus	2 dives from 2 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
12 years	3 dives from 3 groups @ 5.4	plus	2 dives from 2 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
13 years	3 dives from 3 groups @ 5.4	plus	2 dives from 2 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
14 years	3 dives from 3 groups @ 5.4	plus	3 dives from 3 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
15 years	4 dives from 4 groups @ 7.6	plus	3 dives from 3 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
16 years	4 dives from 4 groups @ 7.6	plus	4 dives from 4 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty
17-19 yrs	4 dives from 4 groups @ 7.6	plus	4 dives from 4 groups with no limit on degree of difficulty

#### Platform

- Combination of platforms can be used within the limits as specified by each age group
- No dive can be repeated

10-12 years (5M limit)	2 dives from 2 groups @ 3.6	plus	2 dives from 2 groups with no limit on DD
13- 14 years (5 &/or 7.5)	3 dives from 3 groups @ 5.4	plus	2 dives from 2 groups with no limit on DD
15-16 years (all heights)	3 dives from 3 groups @ 5.5	plus	3 dives from 3 groups with no limit on DD
17-19 years (all heights)	4 dives from 4 groups @ 7.6	plus	3 dives from 3 groups with no limit on DD

### **SELECTION GUIDELINES**

School Sport Australia Championships consists of both educational and sporting components. Being a member of a School Sport Victoria Team Vic representative team provides the opportunity to be involved in all educational and sporting excursions and aim for national selection.

Team Officials run a selection process that is fair and transparent. This process involves the design of guidelines and trial activities, assessment of players and ensuring students, parents and teachers are made aware of this process.

#### Team members are expected to abide by the following responsibilities:

- Attend all sessions (i.e., including but not limited to initial briefing, training, practise matches, uniform presentation, team photo etc.,) as deemed compulsory by Team Officials
- Must be accompanied by a parent/carer to the 2024 Championships. Parent/carer is responsible for the travel, meals and accommodation for themselves and their child
- Purchase the compulsory uniform
- Complete and return all team documentation to the Team Manager by the due date
- Pay all team membership invoices by the due date
- Attend all SSA Championship sessions, including the opening and closing ceremonies and the championship team experience as per the <u>SSA Championship Attendance Policy</u>
- Recognise that the SSA Championships are school activities, and the decision-making regarding each team member's participation in those activities or in preparation for those activities, is the responsibility of the Team Officials
- Be respectful of the role of the Team Officials in making decisions regarding each team member's participation in SSA Championship activities or other preparation activities
- Follow <u>COVID-19 guidance to protect yourselves and others</u> and comply with any health advice that is issued.
