There is a small number of multiclass entries and the parents/teachers of these students will be advised at the start of the day when the heats will be held.

The proposed time to start the heats in each of the events are:

- FREESTYLE: 9:40 am
- BREASTSTROKE: 10:15 am
- BACKSTROKE: 10:50 am
- BUTTERFLY: 11:30 am

There will be a break of approximately 20 minutes between the individual events and relays.

- RELAYS: 12:15 am

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. REMINDERS:

- a. The **City of Greater Geelong has a no photographs or recording policy at the Kardinia Aquatic Centre**. This policy covers all areas within the boundary fences. A designated photographer will take photos of the placegetters after they have been presented with their ribbons. The photos will be posted on the SSV website.
- b. Students are not permitted to use the second pool for a warm up/down or recreational swim at any time during the day
2. Marshalling for the events will be about 10 minutes prior to the start of each age group's heats. Students should ensure they are at the pool before their estimated marshalling time in case the program is running ahead of schedule.
3. **The above is a guide, not definite times.** The program will not be stopped for a break if it gets ahead of the proposed schedule.
4. **In each Division, the first two placegetters in individual events and the winning relay team will advance to the Regional event on Tuesday 28th March. The event will be held at the Kardinia Aquatic Centre.** If you qualify for the Region event and know you will not be able to compete, please inform the officials before the presentation ceremony so the next placed person can be given the information.
5. Programs will not be available on the day. Schools are responsible for giving students a copy of the program.
