PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Each DISTRICT may nominate (2) competitors for each individual event and (2) teams for each relay event.
- 2. Ages are calculated as at December 31st, 2022 Whichever age you turn in 2022 is the age group you will be competing in. A student turning the age of 8 in the event year is not peritted to participate at a Division level.
- 3. A child is permitted to enter two (2) individual events, and one (1) freestyle relay and one (1) Open Medley Relay. No child may enter the same event in two (2) different age groups.
- 4. Entries close on Wednesday the 9th of March. Entries must be submitted by the district coordinators ONLY. No indivudal school entries will be accepted.
- 5. Swimmers will be competing in seperate Division Finals (Hobsons Bay & Wyndham)
 The 1st and 2nd place getter from all individual Division Finals and the 1st placed team for all relay finals will proceed to the Western Metropolitan Region Finals on Tuesday 5th April at
 KARDINIA AQUATIC CENTRE (Park Lane, South Geelong, 3220)
- 6. This meet will be conducted under Swimming Victoria guidelines along with policies and procedures of School Sport Victoria. Swimming Victoria officials will be in attendance on the day.
- 7. Entry Spectators could be asked to pay an entrance fee of \$2.50 at the main entrance gate (Charged by Werribee Outdoor Pool) Children free (paid for from levy paid by Districts).
